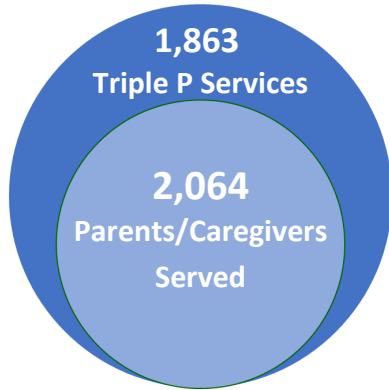

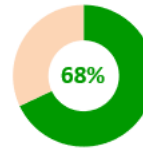
An evidence-based, multi-tiered system for improving parenting practices, family well-being, and children's social and emotional well-being.



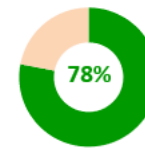
Calendar Years 2015-2018



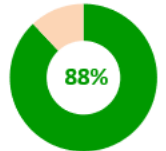
Parent Depression

Parent Stress

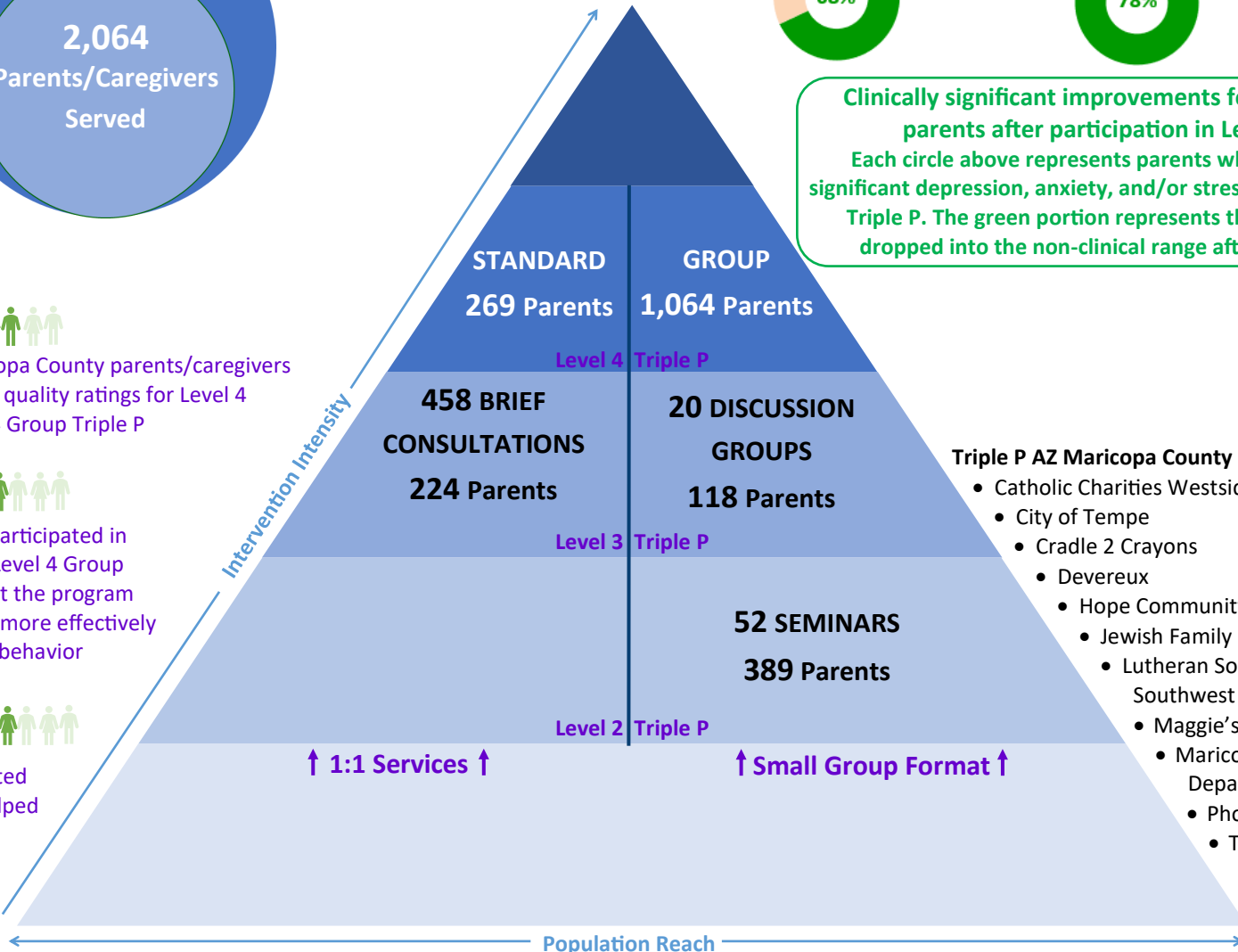


Clinically significant improvements for Maricopa County parents after participation in Level 4 Triple P:
Each circle above represents parents who reported clinically significant depression, anxiety, and/or stress prior to participating in Triple P. The green portion represents the percentage who then dropped into the non-clinical range after completing Triple P.

8 out of 10 Maricopa County parents/caregivers reported the highest quality ratings for Level 4 Standard and Level 4 Group Triple P

7 out of 10 who participated in Level 4 Standard or Level 4 Group Triple P reported that the program helped them to deal more effectively with their children's behavior

7 out of 10 reported that the program helped them to deal more effectively with problems that arise in their families
